







Inside out stories and nursery rhymes in Rainbow Nursery

A repetitive and rhythmical traditional story which adds one character to the sequence each time, supporting re-telling skills	A rhyming text with catchy refrains which encourages children to join in. The flaps and holes make it an interactive and memorable story.	A traditional tale which encourages prediction. It follows a clear sequence with a twist at the end. It provides opportunities to discuss familiar materials and ‘forces’.	A traditional tale with a simple adventure story-line and repeated refrains. This provides an opportunity to embed the concept of a beginning, a middle and an end to a story.	A story about growth and change with repeated phrases. Opportunities to embed concepts including the days of the week and counting as well as developing vocabulary for food. It also introduces the lifecycle of the butterfly.	The pattern and rhythm of the book invites children to join in. The story provides opportunities to play with sound and sound effects and to embed directional language.
Enormous, huge, heave, planted, budge.	Telescope, testing, yells, surprise, glad.	Peeped, squealed, bellowed, beware, scurried, crept.	Goosey, crumbly, piping hot, munching, feast.
