## Dear Parents.

After an amazing year of achievement for Latchmere chess pupils we are again offering a Y3-Y6 After School session and Y3-Y4 and Y5-Y6 Lunchtime sessions; continuing to offer the incredibly popular lunchtime chess to Y1 and Y2 pupils as well! With limited places available, After School is for intermediate/advanced players only. Lunchtime sessions are open to pupils of any standard including complete beginners on a first-come-first-served basis.

Chess is a fun game. It improves concentration, memory, cognitive thinking and calculating ability. It also develops analytical skills, training the mind to plan ahead.

## We play and learn about strategy and tactics together

Although fun, it is not just about winning. They will learn from their losses and become more **resilient** and how to stay **calm under pressure**. You will see them grow in confidence as they progress. **Last year, several players were selected for Surrey!** 

This Autumn Term all children will be prepared for the popular UK Chess Challenge (70,000 kids nationwide take part!) which starts in the Spring Term. This year Latchmere achieved 10 Giga Finalists. We became the first ever again State Primary to become GNSCC Girls Finalists. Five Latchmere pupils represented Surrey and one, our first ever England player!

Our names are Mark & Hilary Hogarth. We are very experienced Chess teachers. Mark is also a Junior Chess County selector/coach, England Senior International and qualified Chess Arbiter. Complete beginners are taught from scratch until ready for assimilation into main group which covers Openings/middlegame strategy/basic endgames & mating patterns.

Cost for the Term is **£70 for lunch time**, **£90 for After School**. If you are in receipt of Pupil Premium or equivalent then chess maybe **free and you must contact the school directly**.
